The file NL_Municipalities2010.TAB is offered to you by TWIAV – Tips & Tricks (www.twiav.nl).

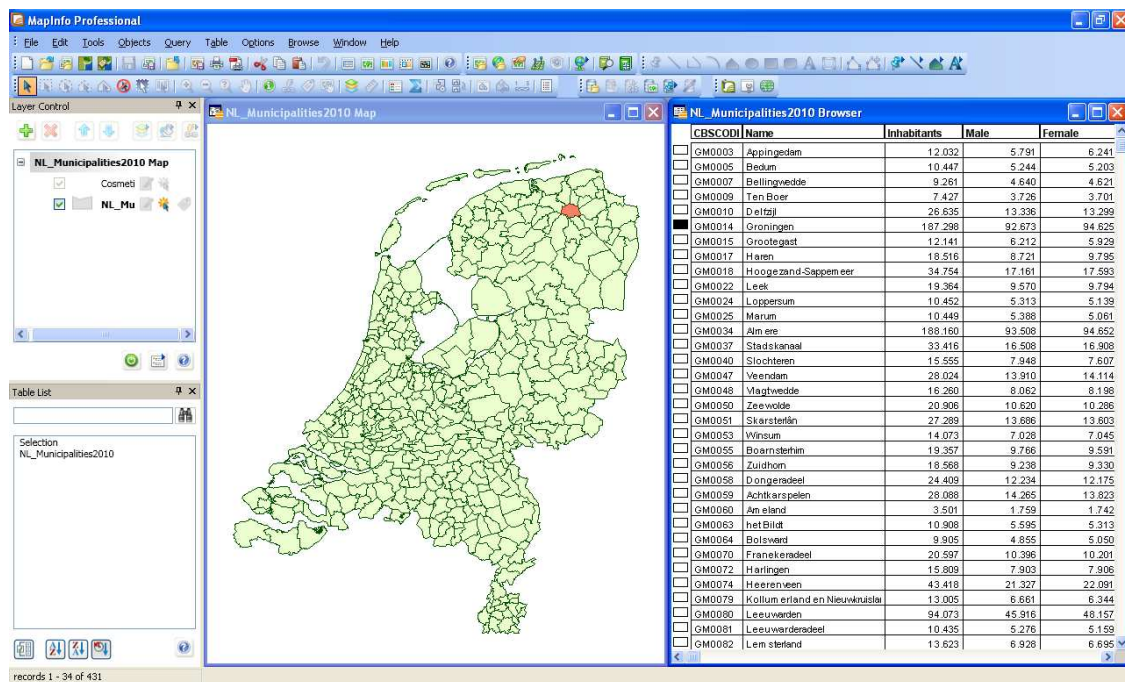
You can use these data to practice with and to get to know MapInfo Professional.

CBSCODE	A unique code assigned to a municipality by the Dutch national statistical office.
Name	Official name of the municipality.
Inhabitants	Number of inhabitants on January, 1 st 2010
Male	Number of male inhabitants
Female	Number of female inhabitants
inh_under_5	Number of inhabitants 0 to 4 years old
inh_5_9	Number of inhabitants 5 to 9 years old
inh_10_14	Number of inhabitants 10 to 14 years old
inh_15_19	Number of inhabitants 15 to 19 years old
inh_20_24	Number of inhabitants 20 to 24 years old
inh_25_44	Number of inhabitants 25 to 44 years old
inh_45_64	Number of inhabitants 45 to 64 years old
inh_65_79	Number of inhabitants 65 to 79 years old
inh_80_and_older	Number of inhabitants 80 years of age and older
Surface_total	Total surface of the municipality (square kilometers).
Surface_land	Total land surface of the municipality (square kilometers).
Surface_inner_water	Total surface of inner water within the municipality (square kilometers)
Surface_outer_water	Total surface of outer water within the municipality (square kilometers)
Density	Population density: number of inhabitants per square kilometer land surface
Region_code	Code indicating the division of The Netherlands into 4 regions (NUTS 1)*
Region_name	Name indicating the division of The Netherlands into 4 regions (NUTS 1)



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Province_code	Code indicating the division of The Netherlands into 12 provinces (NUTS 2)
Province_name	Name indicating the division of The Netherlands into 12 provinces (NUTS 2)
COROP_code	Code indicating the statistical division of The Netherlands into 40 so-called COROP regions (NUTS 3)
COROP_name	Name indicating the statistical division of The Netherlands into 40 so-called COROP regions (NUTS 3)
Police_district_code	Code indicating the division of The Netherlands into 25 Police districts.
Police_district_name	Name indicating the division of The Netherlands into 25 Police districts.
Urban_aggl_code**	Code indicating the 22 urban agglomerations.
Urban_aggl_name	Name indicating the 22 urban agglomerations.
Urbanized_region_code**	Code indicating the 22 urbanized regions (i.e. the urban agglomerations with the surrounding urbanized areas).
Urbanized_region_name	Name indicating the 22 urbanized regions (i.e. the urban agglomerations with the surrounding urbanized areas).

* **NUTS**: Nomenclature of territorial units for statistics - NUTS - Statistical Regions of Europe

** According to the Dutch national statistical office there are 22 urban agglomerations and urbanized regions in The Netherlands.
